



Pumpkin Season FAQ's

When are you open?

We are open 10AM-6PM on September 29th - October 30, and 10AM-3PM on October 31st.

Is Faulkner's a u-pick patch?

Nope, we contract with local growers to provide our customers with a variety of high quality pumpkins and specialty gourds. They are on display and available for purchase in the Harvest Barn.

How much is admission?

Monday-Friday: \$8+tax

Saturday and Sunday: \$10+tax

Happy Hour: (Monday-Thursday from 3PM-6PM) \$5+tax

Children ages 2 and under are always free.

What discounts do you offer?

Throughout the season there are several ways to save:

Grandparents' Weekend- Grandparents receive \$1.00 off admission with the purchase of a grandchild's admission. One Grandparent per paid grandchild.

Pumpkin Par-Tay Weekend - Bring a donation item for Midwest Animal ResQ & save \$1 off admission.

Wild Western Weekend- Get duded up in your best Western gear & save \$1 off admission. (Cowboy hat, boots, bandana)

Halloween Weekend- Bring a winter wear item to donate to the Community Assistance Council and receive \$1 off admission.

Military Discount- \$1 off admission with an ID. Cannot be combined with any other offer.

Can I bring my dog?

Insurance does not permit any outside animals.

What is funny money?

Funny money is required for the four optional attractions: Mechanical Bull, Corn Cannon, Pony Rides, and Zipline. \$5. No refunds.

What forms of payment do you accept?

Cash, as well as all major credit cards.

Can we bring our lunch? What is there to eat?

Only weekday school field trips may bring a sack lunch. No other outside food or beverage is permitted.

Can I bring a stroller?

Yes!

Can we smoke or use e-cigarettes?

No. We do not allow smoking or vaping on the property during Pumpkin Season.
